NOTICE OF RACE

All races activities shall be executed as per the regulations on matter for contrast and containment of COVID 19 diffusion issued by the Italian Sailing Federation activated by the OA. Competitors shall have to follow such regulation under the control of the OA itself. Eventual cases of COVID 19 noted during the event will be denounced by the OA to the sanitary authority.

1 – ORGANISATION

Under delegation of the Italian Federation of Sailing, the regatta is organized by Yacht Club Imperia with the support of Lega Navale Imperia and Assonautica Imperia

2 – SCHEDULE

2.1 for Dragon Class

- Wednesday September 9th: arrivals, registration and inspections.
- Thursday September 10th races, first warning signal at 12:00 p.m.
- Friday September 11th and Saturday September 12th: races
- Sunday September 13th: races. Hauling.
- Monday September 14th: hauling (time set to be communicate)
- 8 races will be possibly sailed, maximum 2 every day, with the possibility to sail a daily race more in case of delay or of forecast delay on the schedule.

2.2 for the 5.5 SI Class

- Wednesday September 9th: arrivals, registration and inspections.
- Thursday September 10th races, first warning signal at 12:00 p.m.
- Friday September 11th: races
- Saturday September 12th: races
- Sunday September 13th: hauling. (time set to be communicate)
- 6 races will be possibly sailed, maximum 2 every day, with the possibility to sail a daily race more in case of delay or of forecast delay on the schedule.
- The title of Italian Championship will be assigned with a minimum of three races valid sailed.

2.3 for all classes

- The race office will open since 10.00 a.m. of September 9th
- Briefing Thursday September 10th at 09.30 am
- The schedule time for the first warning signal for following days will be posted within 7:30 pm of the previous day; in case of no notice being posted, the same time as the previous day will be confirmed. The Race Committee may modify at his unquestionable judgemental the schedule for bad weather or for any other circumstances.
- Award ceremony Sunday September 13th at 5:00 p.m.
- NOTE: it is fair to be present at the Opening and Award Ceremonies by a minimum one person.

3 – ELIGIBILITY AND CATEGORIES

3.1 For Dragon Class

3.1.1 Dragon with valid class measurement certificate

3.1.2 Corinthian as per class rule 28.3 for championship, will have to be declared at the entry.

3.1.3 Classics as per traditional planking from years '70

3.1.4 The Italians owners have to be member 2020 of Assodragone

3.2 For 5.5 SI Class

3.2.1 yachts with valid class measurement certificate

4 – ENTRIES

4.1 For all classes

4.1.1 Entry forms shall be sent, **within the July 30th, 2020**, included the entry fee, by mail to: office@ycim.it or on-line on www.ycim.it.

Each eventual delayed entry can be accepted by sole decision of the OA, by a supplementary fee of 100 Euro. Entries will be considerate completed only after full registration and payment of each asked amount.

4.1.2 Payment exclusively by bank transfer: IBAN: IT56 O 08530 10500 000400101078, Banca D'Alba, beneficiary: Yacht Club Imperia ASD. To specify: entry to Dragon Summer Cup, and sail number.

4.1.3 the entries will have to be completed by:

- the appropriate entry fee
- entry form full filled
- copy of the measurement (rating) certificate (original to be showed at the registration)
- crew list:
 - for Italian participants the crew list must be completed by a copy of FIV card 2020 with valid medical examination
 - for foreign participants the crew list needs to be in compliance with their national sailing authority insurance statement **as per annexe** where the insurance company states that the insurance coverage is also extended during sailing competitions, that the civil liability coverage is not lower than 1.500.000,00 euro and that, due to the premium payment, the insurance is valid for the whole racing period.

4.3 ENTRY FEES

4.3.1 for DRAGON Class 400,00 Euro

4.3.2 for 5.5 SI Class 300,00 Euro

4.4 NOTE for all classes

4.4.1 the entry fees above showed will give right to the free mooring, launch and hauling in the time set as above point 2.1 and 2.2.

4.4.2 The eventual ribs of the supports persons will have to accredit they-self by a entry fee of 150.00 Euro which will give the right for mooring, launch and hauling and one bracelet as above.

5 – RULES

5.1 The races will be governed by the *Rules* as defined by World Sailing Rules 2017-2020 RRS, included Italian Sailing Federation prescription WS approved – see:

5.2 For the Italian competitors the “Normativa” FIV will apply

5.3 In case of conflict of interpretation the English language will prevail

5.4 In case of conflict between NOR and SI, the SI will prevail

5.5 The class rule 13.3 will not apply.

5.6 The notices for the competitors, also in compliance with the sanitary regulations, will be posted in the dedicated page of www.racingrulesofsailing.org which will be able also to be used for communication with the RC and Jury, See SI. See QR Code below:



6 – ADVERTISING

As per WS regulation 20, in water and mooring for all period of the event.

7 – COURSES AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The courses will be showed in the Sailing Instructions, which will be available at the Race Office at the registration time.

8 – SCORING AND AWARDS

8.1 Scoring System will be the Low Point as per RRS appendix “A”.

Regatta will be valid with 1 race completed.

The worst score will be excluded from the ranking:

- at the 4th valid race for Dragon Class
- at the 4th valid race for 5.5 SI Class

8.2 Boats will be awarded as per number of competitors

- Ernesto Quaranta Trophy to the first Classic Dragon
- Prize to the first Corinthian Dragon
- Other prizes established by OA will be delivered.

9 – IMAGE RIGHT and RESPONSIBILITY

9.1 By their entry the participants, the owners and their guests grant free and complete permission to the Organising Authority for every video and photo shot of boats and people that are made during the course of the championship and that it can be published or broadcasted to press or any means of information and communication, including television, whether advertising or press release or information.

9.2 The organizing authority, the Race Committee, the Jury and any other parts involved in the organization, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

10 – COLLATERAL EVENTS

Will be communicate on the SI or on the ONB
